**Re: Access to Information Act requests**

This is in response to your requests made under the *Access to Information Act*, which were received in our Department on December 23, 2022, clarified on January 17, 2023, and read as follows:

**A-2022-00380**

**“Provide all official or public statements issued between January 1, 1977 to December 31, 1979 expressing Canada's policy with respect to the "recycling" or "reprocessing" of nuclear fuel waste (irradiated nuclear fuel, spent fuel, CANDU fuel) and/or the extraction of plutonium from nuclear fuel.”**

**“Provide all official or public statements issued between January 1, 1977 to December 31, 1979 expressing Canada's policy with respect to nuclear weapons proliferation and security risks in relation to plutonium (including but not limited to weapons grade plutonium) and /or on control of the movement and access to plutonium to reduce the risk of nuclear weapons proliferation and /or security risks, including by rogue actors.”**

Please be advised that a complete search was made within Natural Resources Canada and we wish to inform you that our Department does not have any information in response to your request.


